Case study/ topic summary: Intensive agricultural production is one of the main drivers for the global decline of agrobiodiversity, yet the adoption of biodiversity-friendly farming practices remains insufficient. The aim of this study is to create a better understanding of the farmers' decision-making on biodiversity. One part of the research process consisted of four workshops with a selected group of stakeholders (public administration, NGOs, farmers' organisations, producer organisations, research, retail, advisory services). The workshops were carried out in Switzerland (eight participants), Romania (ten participants), Germany (six participants) and the UK (four participants) between July and October 2024. Based on the innovation systems analysis (Van Mierlo et al. 2010), participants collectively created matrices that depict structural barriers and enablers for biodiversity conservation in agricultural landscapes, with a special focus on the enabling or restricting role of labour availability for on-farm biodiversity management.
- **5. Purpose of data collection:** The system analysis workshops revealed barriers and enablers for biodiversity conservation in agricultural landscapes from the perspective of a selected group of stakeholders.
