4. **Case study/ topic summary:** The UK case study, Opening Nature and the Outdoors to Black, Asian, and Minority Ethnic Communities, is a creative, participatory project exploring biodiversity and how experiential, creatively driven interventions can inspire change at individual, organisational, and institutional levels. Data was collected over 13 months from five workshops with Dadima's CIC and 11 of their walking group participants, a project WhatsApp group, and two interactive knowledge-sharing sessions involving participants from the walking group. Data was also collected with farmers and local decision-makers in Kigali, Rwanda.
5. **Purpose of data collection:** better understanding the leverage points (barriers and opportunities) for biodiversity engagement via community-led (minoritised) groups in the UK, with visual data helping document the research process, capturing participant engagement and gathering images for project outputs.

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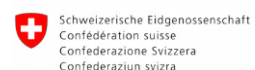
